Although Sparrows may seem common, they're silently disappearing

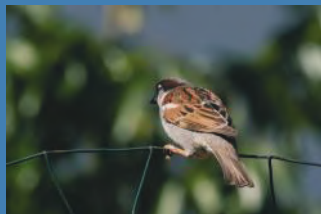


House Sparrow populations have declined by

Why are they declining?

Over **4,000,000** House Sparrows are killed annually by cats

Lack of invertebrates to feed on



Less less spaces to nest and raise young



What can we do?



3 ways we can Save the House Sparrow



Leave a wild area in your garden, by not mowing parts of it to allow wildflowers and invertebrates to colonise it



Provide a home such as a bird box. Just ensure the hole is at least 32mm wide



Feed them yourself with birdfeeders. Mealworms are a favourite!
